

Water in School

It has come to our notice that some children are having juice or flavoured water in their bottles to drink. The school policy is that children are only allowed water in school. There are several reasons for this, the main one being that these juices may be dilute, but the acid in them still stays on a child's teeth and will eventually damage them.
