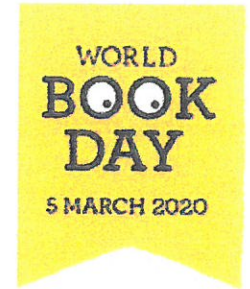
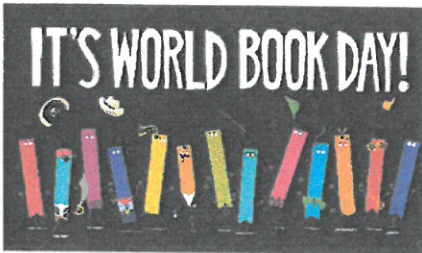


Dear Parents & Carers
