Reference - National Child Measurement Programme 2020 - Impact of Covid 19


Dear Parent,

I am writing to inform you about changes to the arrangements for the National Child Measurement Programme (recording of children's heights and weights in Year R and Year 6) in West Berkshire's primary schools for this academic year 2020-21. Due to the current Covid 19 pandemic, the government has advised providers of this programme to delay re-starting until January 2021; we now anticipate that we will measure Year 6 pupils in January to March 2021 and Year R pupils from March to July 2021. Hearing tests will also be carried out for all Year R children at the same time.

Some of last years Reception class were measured but many were not as services reduced and/or stopped following government guidance. For children who were due to be measured in the last academic year 2019-20 we have been advised that there will be no catchup programme. Therefore, if any parent has concerns about their child's growth and development and would like some support, please contact the West Berkshire School Nursing Team on 01635 273384 . Any child in last years Reception class that did not have a hearing test carried out will now receive this between January and July 2021.
